Sutton Neighbourhood Plan – Brain Storming Meeting – Other Input and Ideas (ad-hoc & email)

- Big support for retaining and protecting the ford and pack horse bridge – seen as one of the villages biggest assets
- Lots of wildlife around the village – need to protect
- Nature reserve – create one
- Solar powered tram to Potton
- Provide a ‘Community Garden’ (similar to Dunton)
- Any new motorised transport links to be sensitively placed and screened from the village (visual and noise)
- Protect the tranquillity of the area
- Protect the area of dark skies
- Intelligent LED street lighting
- Belt of trees as buffer south of Sutton – *[drawn on map]*
- Protect and enhance Lantern Lane as a bridleway only (cycles, horses, walkers), not a road/no motorised vehicles (maybe reinforced grass, definitely not tarmac) *[also drawn on a map]*
- Guarantee maintenance of all the public footpaths and bridleways in the parish by a regular survey.
- Remember we are a rural country parish.
- Playing field and equipment improvements, especially simple things for younger children such as half-buried log, tunnel pipe, etc.
